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# LOGISTICS DEVELOPMENT

Over the last decade (2013-2023), the field of logistics has undergone significant changes and developments, driven by technological advancements, globalization, and a focus on efficiency and sustainability.

Here are some key trends and characteristics that describe logistics during this period:

#### 1.Technology Integration:

a. Automation and Robotics: The last decade witnessed increased use of automation and robotics in warehouses and distribution centres. Automated guided vehicles (AGVs), drones, and robotic arms have been employed to streamline processes and enhance efficiency.

b. IoT (Internet of Things): The integration of IoT devices has enabled real-time tracking and monitoring of shipments, inventory, and vehicles, providing greater visibility and control throughout the supply chain.

In 2022, the global logistics industry continued to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic hit with a market size of approximately 10.41 trillion U.S dollars. By 2028, the logistics industry scale is projected to exceed 14.08 trillion U.S dollars\*.

### 4. Sustainability Initiatives & Collaborative Logistics:

Growing awareness of environmental issues has led to an increased emphasis on sustainability in logistics. Companies are adopting eco-friendly practices, such as optimizing transportation routes, reducing carbon emissions, and employing green technologies.



Size of the logistics industry worldwide 2018-2028\*







### Oman Logistics Center Executive Program and Logistic Best Practice Award Inauguration & Investment Labs in Transport and Logistic Sector 2023 – 2025

On Sunday, October 8th, 2023, H.E Said bin Hamood Al Mawali, Minister of Transport, Communications, and Information Technology, opened the ceremony by highlighting the rapid growth of Oman's logistics sector and emphasizing its significant contribution to the national GDP. In 2022, the sector accounted for approximately RO 2 billion. His Excellency envisions the logistics sector evolving into the second-largest contributor to Oman's economy by 2040.

H.E. Khamis al Shamakhi, Undersecretary for Transport at MTCIT, drew attention to Oman's fifth position on the Arab world's Logistics Performance Index. He provided a breakdown of the sector's GDP contribution, with land transport accounting for 60%, sea transport 6.7%, air transport 3.2%, and warehousing/supporting activities 30%. Moreover, Omani ports witnessed a 21% growth in exports along with an 18% increase in imports and a 3% rise in re-exports in 2022.

The event launched both the Oman Logistic Center Executive program and the logistics Best Practices award inauguration in collaboration with Oman Logistics Association. This accolade aims to recognize outstanding projects from the past year, pushing for enhanced sector efficiency and encouraging competition among businesses and SMEs. The award will feature several categories, including health and safety, Omani products and services, Omanization, net-zero, continuous improvements and innovation.

Event ended with several agreements were signed. Oman National Transport Company – Mwasalat – partnered with Oman Energy Association – Opal – to enhance workforce efficiency in the energy sector. An agreement was also inked between MTCIT and Khazaen City to establish the Khazaen Logistics Complex. Khazaen Dry Port Company additionally entered an agreement to provide comprehensive services at Khazaen Dry Port. Furthermore, MTCIT and the Civil Aviation Authority initiated a two-week program to attract investments to the logistics sector.

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# Awareness session about logistics sector at MCBS

On December 2023,5, a team from Oman Logistic Center in the Ministry of Transport, Communication and Information Technology visited Modern College of Business and Science. The main objective of their visit was to provide the audience with a comprehensive overview of logistics in Oman and the role of Oman Logistics Center. The session specifically targeted students and academic staff who are majoring in logistics and supply chain management. It must have been a valuable opportunity for them to learn about the logistics industry in Oman and gain insights into the various aspects of this field. Additionally, Oman Logistic Association also took part in the visit and provided a brief introduction to the services they offer to private logistics companies. This would have given the audience a broader understanding of the resources and support available within the industry.

# Integrated Logistics One-Stop Inspection and Clearance Station's Standards

Recently, Oman Logistics Center (OLC) at the Ministry of Transport, Communications and Information Technology is the authority organizing the establishment and operation of Integrated Logistics One-Stop Inspection and Clearance Station. Final approval must be obtained from OLC before establishing any logistical station for inspection and clearance, as it is the competent authority for that. The management of integrated logistics stations for inspection and clearance applies to all goods entering the region. Or emerge from it and the same controls and procedures stipulated in the applicable laws as executive regulations and ministerial decisions applied.





# Mwasalat's Comprehensive Impact on Oman's Public Transport and Regional Development

#### • Mwasalat Launches New Muscat - Al Buraimi - Abu Dhabi Route via Al Ain

Mwasalat, a member of Asyad Group, launched a new route on October 1, 2023, connecting Muscat to Abu Dhabi via Al Buraimi and Al Ain. This service includes key stops at Azaiba Bus Station, Muscat International Airport, and Abu Dhabi Bus Station, utilizing Al Batinah Expressway for part of the journey to ensure a quick and smooth trip.

The service, initially offering one round trip daily, departs Muscat at 6:30 AM, arriving in Abu Dhabi at 3:40 PM, and returns from Abu Dhabi at 10:45 AM. It's tailored for both business and leisure travelers, providing flexibility and convenience. The fare is 11.5 Omani Rials for a one way trip from Muscat to Abu Dhabi, and 22 Omani Rials for a round trip.

Passenger comfort is a priority, with the buses offering free Wi-Fi, USB ports, and comfortable seating. The buses also meet international safety standards and are equipped with the latest safety technology. This new route is expected to boost travel and economic ties between Oman and the UAE, linking Muscat, Al Buraimi, and Abu Dhabi.

Adding to this, the statistics of the route from October 1 to November 30, 2023 has showed impressive results, over 7,000 passengers have been transported. Remarkably, the seat occupancy rate reached 118%, with around 5,000 passengers transported in November alone. This data highlights the route's success and its growing popularity among travelers.

#### Over 3 Million Passengers in Q3 of 2023

Mwasalat has marked a significant milestone in the 3rd quarter of 2023 by transporting over 3.1 million passengers, a clear testament to its expanding influence in Oman's public transportation sector. Mwasalat has managed an impressive daily average of over 11.5 thousand passengers through its bus services. Additionally, ferry services played a substantial role, transporting more than 177 thousand passengers at a daily average of over 652 passengers.

The company's achievements extend to freight and vehicle transportation, with over 45.6 thousand vehicles and more than 18 thousand tons of goods transported through its ferry fleet. These figures underscore Mwasalat's essential role in supporting Oman's economic and social infrastructure.

The increment in passenger numbers can largely be attributed to Mwasalat's efforts in enhancing customer experience, particularly through the introduction of the online reservation system. This innovation has simplified the booking process, contributing significantly to the increase in passenger numbers. Furthermore, Mwasalat's commitment to community and economic development is evident in its corporate social responsibilities, including providing extensive training opportunities and supporting local small and medium enterprises.

The demographic breakdown of passengers shows that Omani nationals constituted about 34.98% of intercity bus users and 80.68% on ferries. Special attention to inclusivity is seen in Mwasalat's policy of reserving priority seats for females and families, with females comprising approximately 12.73% of bus users and around 21.34% on ferries. The company's Omanization strategy in its various departments has reached a significant 93%.

### · Mwasalat Signs Strategic Partnership with OPAL

Strengthening its commitment to sustainability and excellence in transport sector, Mwasalat has signed a strategic partnership with Oman Energy Society (OPAL). This collaboration is aimed at enhancing the qualifications and training of personnel in the energy, minerals, and transport sectors. The focus of this agreement is on achieving sustainability goals, particularly in human resource development and evolving the transport ecosystem.

The partnership is set to develop and implement joint training plans and educational programs in logistics, aligning with the standards of the Ministry of Higher Education, Research, and Innovation. It emphasizes the importance of innovation, with both parties committing to explore digital solutions for vehicle management and logistics. This cooperation will also delve into sustainability initiatives in logistics, like carbon removal plans and promoting green mobility, reflecting a shared commitment to environmental stewardship and sustainable development.

### Mwasalat CEO Elected as Chair of UITP MENA Bus Working Group and Vice Chair of the UITP MENA Executive Committee

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In a significant development for Oman's presence in the global public transport sector, Bader bin Mohammed Al Nadabi, CEO of Mwasalat, has been elected as the Chair of the UITP (International Association of Public Transport) MENA Bus Working Group for 2023-2025. This election is a testament to his leadership and the trust placed in Omani expertise in the public transport sector.

This appointment is not only elevates Oman's regional influence but also enhances its international standing in public transportation. This role places him at the forefront of discussions and developments in the public transport sector across the MENA region, allowing him to contribute significantly to shaping



the future of transportation in this area. Earlier in the year, Al Nadabi was also appointed as the Vice Chair of the UITP MENA Executive Committee, further solidifying his and Mwasalat's leadership roles in the industry. These dual roles underscore the growing importance of Oman and Mwasalat in the global public transport landscape.

UITP, established in 1885, is the premier global network connecting all stakeholders in public transport, including over 1600 members ranging from government bodies, transport operators, manufacturers, and developers of intelligent transport systems from 96 countries. 




# Women in Logistics

# Elite Co. Paving the Way for Enhanced Logistics Efficiency in Oman






